According to my colleagues, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], the number is well over 1 million:

[REDACTED] had calculated that 2,854,824 PDFs were downloaded in November and December. Another 438,745 were downloaded during the first week in January bringing the Nov-Jan total to 3,275,704. We also know that downloads occurred in Oct, but we don't have those numbers.
